## **OBLIGATIONS OF FULL-TIME GRADUATE STUDY**

CCC staff who are granted full-time graduate study must fulfill the following obligations. If you have any questions regarding these obligations please discuss them with the Director of Theological Development in your region (or other member of the HR team designated by your HRL director.)

1. I understand that I am morally and legally obligated to a year-for-year “payback” for each year I pursue full-time graduate study. (If you are approved for graduate study, you will be required to sign a legal agreement stating your intention to fulfill this requirement.)
2. I understand that I will still be required to attend certain CCC conferences including the biennial National Staff Conference in Fort Collins as well as annual conferences stipulated by my regional team (e.g., Regional Staff Conference, Christmas Conference, etc.).
3. I understand that my full-time graduate study status applies only during the school year and that I will receive a summer assignment from my Regional Team each summer. I also understand that, if qualified, I may be asked to serve for at least one summer as a TA for the *Institute of Biblical Studies*.
4. I understand that I am required to invest the equivalent of one day per week (eight hours in a forty hour work week) in personal ministry with the Campus Ministry.
5. I understand that my spouse will be expected to have a full-time campus ministry assignment (unless my spouse has also been approved for graduate study or must take care of our children).
6. I understand that my study is not merely for my own development. Whenever possible I will seek to do research that will benefit the Campus Ministry.
7. I will seek to glorify Christ through my study.
